As a member of the Business Operations team, the Project Manager (PM) will assist executives and founders of newly formed companies as they transition to operational businesses. The PM will facilitate team meetings, ensure proper activity documentation, assist in reporting to General Inception (GI) management and contribute to the build-out and continuous improvement of the overall GI process. This is a hands-on role. The PM will work simultaneously with multiple small teams to meet demanding time and budget constraints.
